





MATERIALS

Recipe for "Mile High Bubbles" from Mick Telkamp 2 cups warm water 1/4 cup corn syrup 1/3 cup dish soap

Stir together warm water & corn syrup. Add dish soap (Dawn's classic blue formula is well-regarded) and gently mix in.

HOMEMADE BUBBLE SOAP

SUPPLIES FOR PLAYING "Will It Make a Bubble?"

- Plastic cups (Punch a hole in the bottom to blow through. Dip the large open end into the solution and blow.)
- Plastic soft drink bottles (Cut the bottom off the bottle and dip. Blow through lid-end opening.)
- Pipe cleaners (Bend into endless shapes, keeping a small section as a handle.)
- Plastic funnels (Dip the large end and blow through the small end.)
- Drinking straws (Good for fast and small bubbles. Try taping a handful together and see what happens!)
- Cardboard tubes
- Cookies cutters (Remember to blow against the dull edge.)
- Any kitchen tool with a hole in it (potato masher, slotted spoon, etc.).
- Fly swatters (Because waving creates bubbles just as well as blowing.)
