DIRECTIONS

- 1. Print out the heart template and cut it out.
- 2. Allow the child to trace the heart template onto construction paper.
- 3. Have the child select objects from a number of options. Set them aside on a paper plate.
- 4. Provide the child with glue and let them decorate away!


