

**MATERIALS**

Cardboard

Assorted bottle caps

Glue

Washable stamp pads or paint daubers

Foam or felt stickers, foam sheets, buttons,  
toothpicks, popsicle sticks, yarn, bubble  
wrap, dry pasta, plastic drinking straws

Plain white or kraft wrapping paper

# HOLIDAYS WITH HEART: HOMEMADE WRAPPING PAPER

**STEP 1**

Make a base for your stamp with a bottle cap or square of cardboard (fold a second strip of cardboard into an "L" shape and glue it to one side of your square for a handle). Corks, blocks, and spools work too!

**STEP 2**

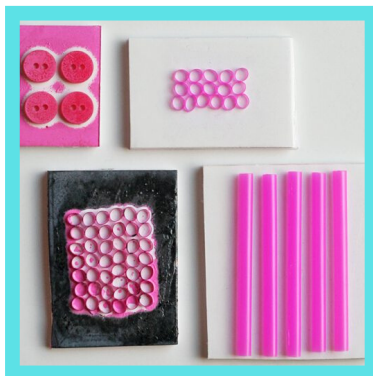
Glue a single object or make a pattern of objects on the flat side of your stamp base. Get as creative as you'd like! Foam sheets can be cut into shapes of all types & sizes. Inexpensive seasonal foam or felt stickers make it easy to recreate holiday silhouettes. Or try attaching buttons, toothpick stripes, squiggles of yarn, pieces of bubble wrap, or sections of drinking straws to see what interesting patterns they create.

**STEP 3**

Use water-based stamping pads (like these from Amazon [https://www.amazon.com/dp/B07RY6BCLP/ref=cm\\_sw\\_em\\_r\\_mt\\_dp\\_U\\_n5.7DbM52CTXT](https://www.amazon.com/dp/B07RY6BCLP/ref=cm_sw_em_r_mt_dp_U_n5.7DbM52CTXT)) or dab paint directly on stamp with a paint dauber. Stamp anywhere & everywhere!
